

Top stories this week

- ⇒ US President Donald Trump and his Chinese counterpart Xi Jinping have established the US-China Comprehensive Dialogue and agreed to expand areas of cooperation while managing differences based on mutual respect, the White House said today.
- ⇒ Exchanges, depositories pitch E-IPO, faster clearances to SEBI chief Ajay Tyagi
- ⇒ Ajay Tyagi, chairman of the Securities and Exchanges Board of India, today met with the officials of national exchanges, depositories and Clearing Corporation for the first time since taking over office.
- ⇒ Regulator Trai today expressed concern over the quality of broadband service in India and stressed the need to have 'broadband labeling' that will help consumers make an informed choice in picking a service provider.
- ⇒ Post RBI policy, short-term debt funds, dynamic bond funds can be more rewarding than bank FDs
- ⇒ The US and Russia clashed in the UN Security Council over the missile attack on a Syrian airfield, with Washington warning it is "prepared to do more" as Moscow accused it of flagrantly violating international law with its "act of aggression."
- ⇒ Executives of state oil firms met Oil Minister Dharmendra Pradhan and the ministry officials on Wednesday to discuss the idea of daily fuel pricing. "The idea of daily fuel pricing has been there for sometime. But now we have the technology to implement it. So we will do it," a top executive said, without giving a timeline for the launch.

India to sign two major defence deals with Bangladesh

- ⇒ Reserve Bank of India allowing banks to invest in Real Estate Investment Trusts (REITs) and Infrastructure Investment Trusts (InvITs), the outlook for the realty counter has improved further.
- ⇒ Wall Street down after weak jobs, Fed comments, Syria airstrikes. *Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 6.85 points, or 0.03 percent, at 20,656.1, the S&P 500 lost 1.95 points, or 0.08 percent, to 2,355.54 and the Nasdaq Composite dropped 1.14 points, or 0.02 percent, to 5,877.81.*
